

Confirmation Program Description

About the Series

The **Sola Confirmation Series** was written to serve as a straightforward and practical resource for teaching

Confirmation. Its simple format does not require an elaborate program and extensive congregational resources, and is particularly suited to smaller churches.



The "old-school" workbook format allows a pastor or lay leader, with little advance preparation, to sit down with students and take them page by page through a lesson together. The series was written so that both the adult leaders and the students are able to explore a

biblical concept on the same level. The lessons do not assume a high level of prior knowledge.

Each of the four core workbooks in the *Sola Confirmation Series* is laid out in ten sessions, covering one major section of *Luther's Small Catechism*. But the core series also provides students an overview and sense for the interconnectedness of Scripture built into each session. Rather than creating

an artificial split between the study of Scripture and the study of the Catechism, the series takes a "Bible Study" approach to teaching students. Scripture is

used throughout the series as the primary

text and teaching resource for instruction.

Unlike some other Confirmation curricula, the *Sola Confirmation Series* intentionally takes a more "content-based" approach to teaching. Employing many learning styles, forms of presentation, and means of group engagement, the main emphasis in the Sola series is on communicating the Word of God and the content of the Christian faith.

We believe that the heart of the Lutheran understanding of *Sola Scriptura* (Scripture alone) is the confidence that God actually creates faith by means of his Word. Through Law and Gospel, God does more than just impart information. He lays hold of our hearts and gives us something outside of ourselves in which we can trust and believe.

As Scripture says: "These are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name." (John 20:31). That is the goal of this series.

Format of the Student Workbooks

Each lesson in the *Sola Confirmation Series* is written with a consistent format. Some of the standard pieces included with each lesson are:

1) Opening Scripture Dialog & Prayer

Written to be spoken by Leader (L) and Class (C), the dialog allows each lesson to begin with Scripture and prayer. The leader part may be the class teacher or a designated student.

2) Gathering Activity

A simple warm-up activity is provided to begin each lesson. These may need to be adjusted for available space and the size of a given class. Look for the thematic connection between the activity and the session topic.

3) Theme Word Definition

The first page of each lesson introduces the theme with an opening illustration and presents the "theme word" for the lesson (which is also the session title). This is intended to set the stage for the study that follows.

4) Quoted and "Look-up" Scripture Texts

The heart of each lesson is the Scripture texts around which the session is built, often with questions for reflection. In addition, each lesson also contains shorter "quoted" texts in a section titled "Reading God's Word," intended to serve as a broader reinforcement of the theme.

5) Catechism: Fill-in-the-Blank Section

Each lesson contains the passage of the Small Catechism under discussion. The "fill in the blank" format is meant to be a practice for memory work. The *Sola Confirmation Series* makes use of the **Luther's Small Catechism**, 2010 Edition, from Sola and ReClaim. The section of the Catechism being covered is also found on the last page of the workbook.

6) Illustrations & Object Lessons

Many lessons feature a graphic/pictorial presentation of the theme, or include an in-class object lesson. These are usually the only portions that require advance set-up.

7) Small Group Bible Study

Each lesson features a Bible study, intended for table discussion. Larger classes can be broken down into groups of 5-8 students, facilitated by an adult small group leader.

8) Memory Symbol

A memory symbol and short description is provided for each lesson for students to solidify the concept in their minds and remember what has been covered.

9) ADTRC Prayer

Each lesson asks students to write their own prayer, using the ADTRC prayer format (described on the next page).

A Typical Year's Program Schedule:

FALL:

First Unit: 10 weeks
- full workbook (Rally Sunday to Christmas)

WINTER:

Second Unit: 5 weeks
- 1st half of workbook (New Year to Lent)

LENT:

Video Series and Lenten Services (Ash Wed. to Easter)

SPRING:

Second Unit: 5 weeks
- 2nd half of workbook (Easter to Mem. Day)

Sola Confirmation Series - Four Core Workbooks

The four core books in the Sola Confirmation Series each have ten sessions, covering a major section of Luther's Small Catechism. A biblical overview of Scripture from both the Old and New Testaments incorporated into the framework of the series. When using the series in a two-year rotation, students may begin in either of the alternating years. Normally, one unit is presented in the Fall, with another unit presented in the Winter & Spring. Some congregations choose to show a biblical video series over a number of weeks, for a portion of the year (for example, during Lent).


