O tidings of comfort and joy.

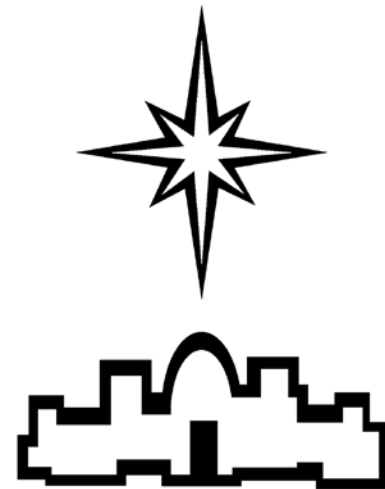
From God our heavenly Father a blessed angel came,
