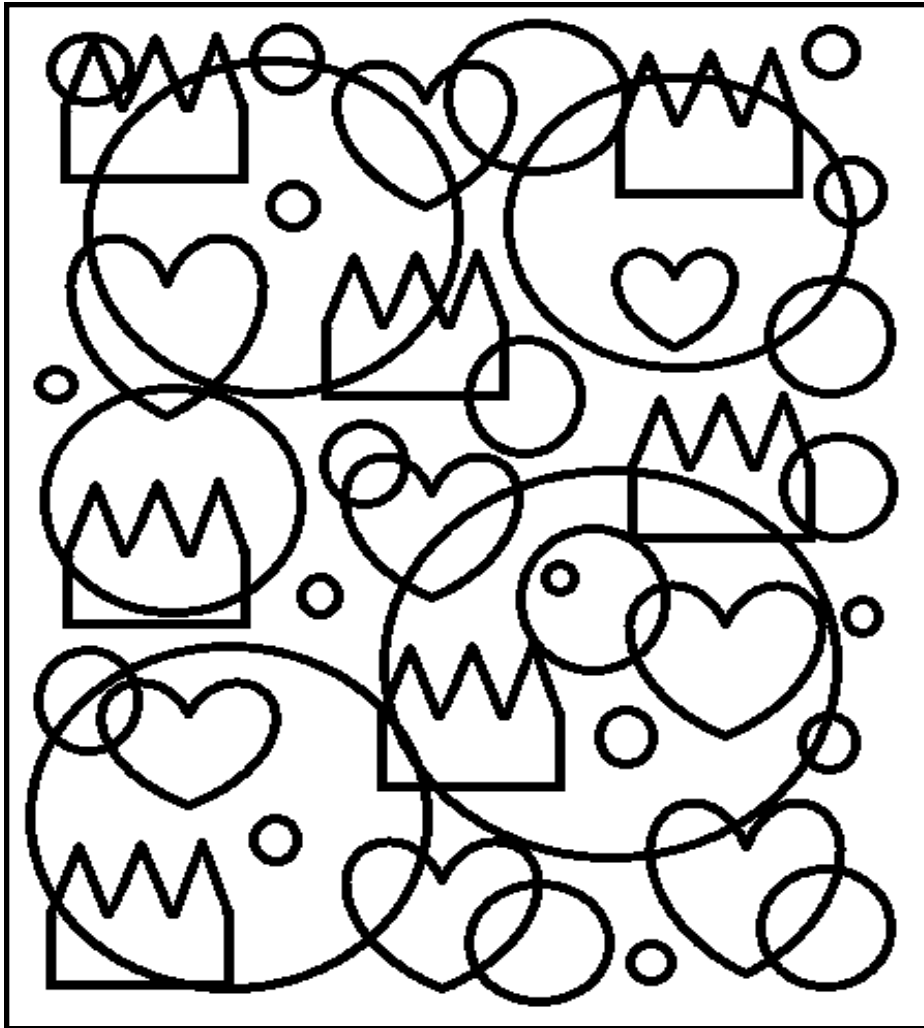


Jesus was baptized in the Jordan River.
