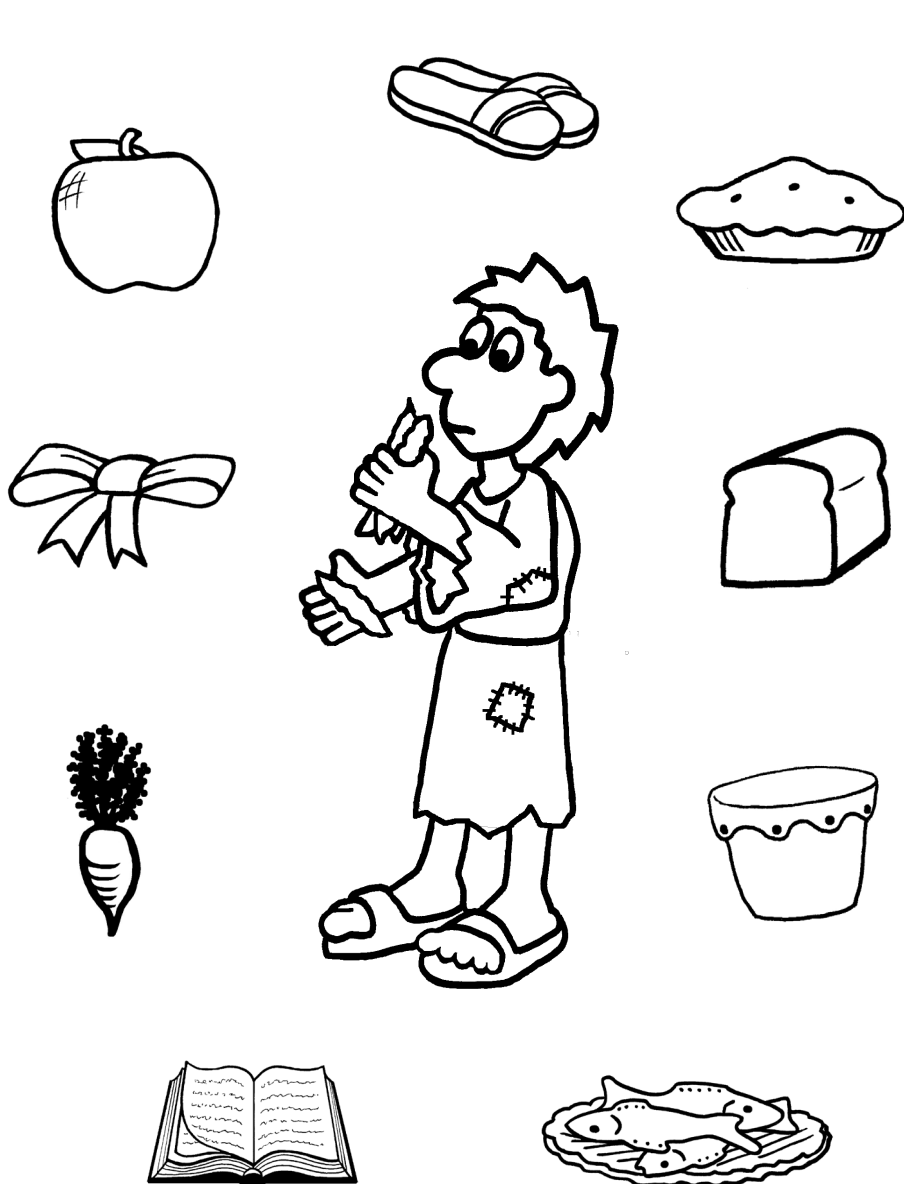


When a lost son came home, his father was very glad!

He was so hungry that he wished he could eat their food!

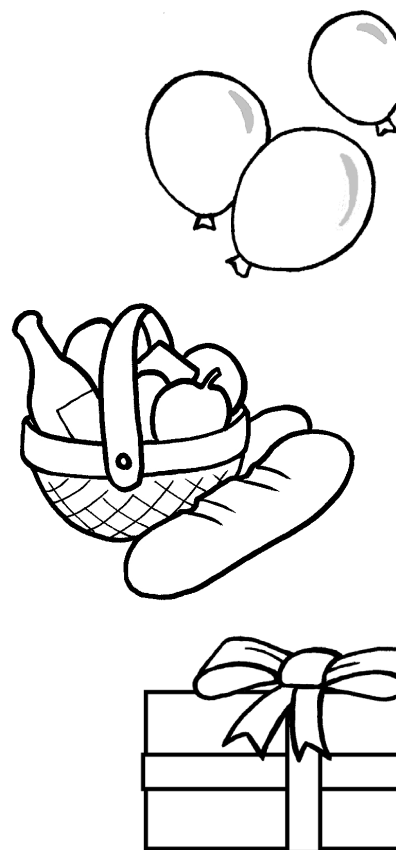
Draw a line from the son to anything that he could eat.
