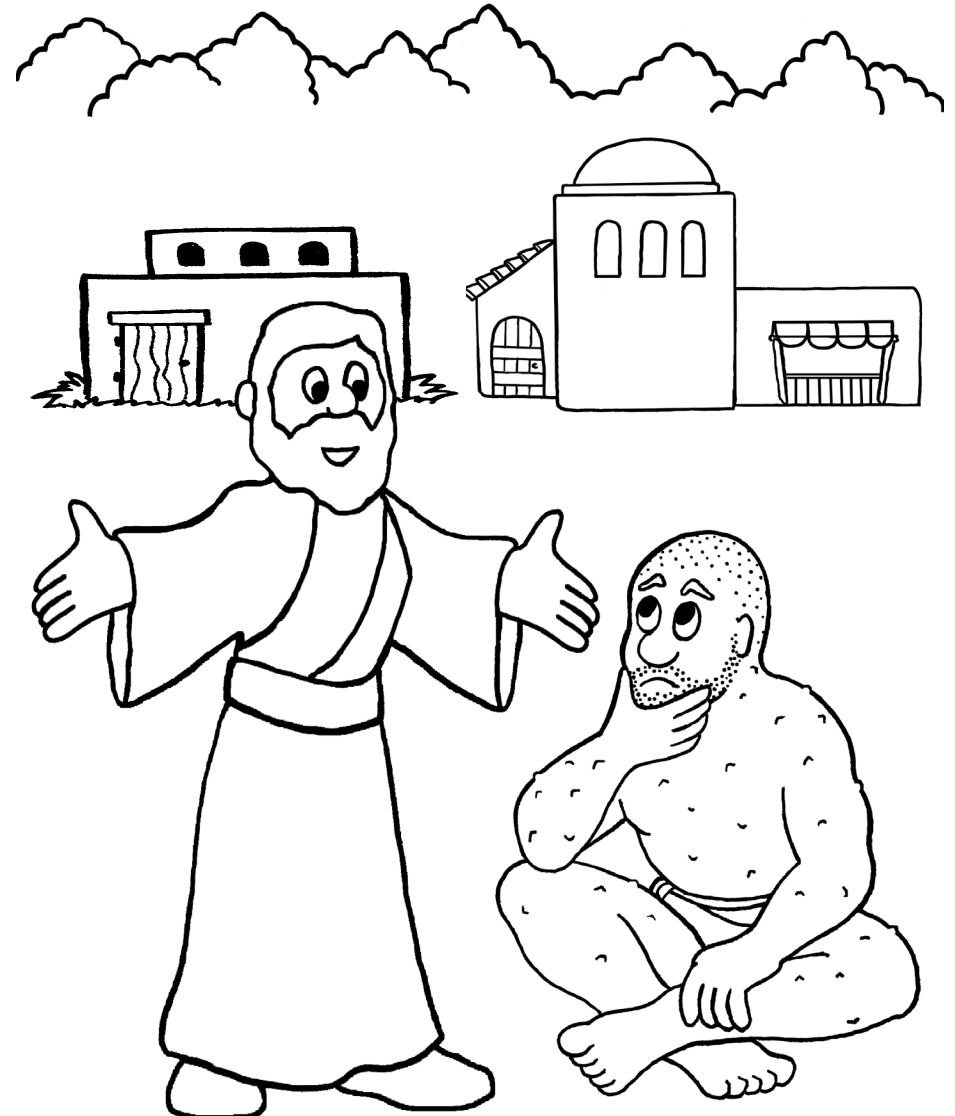

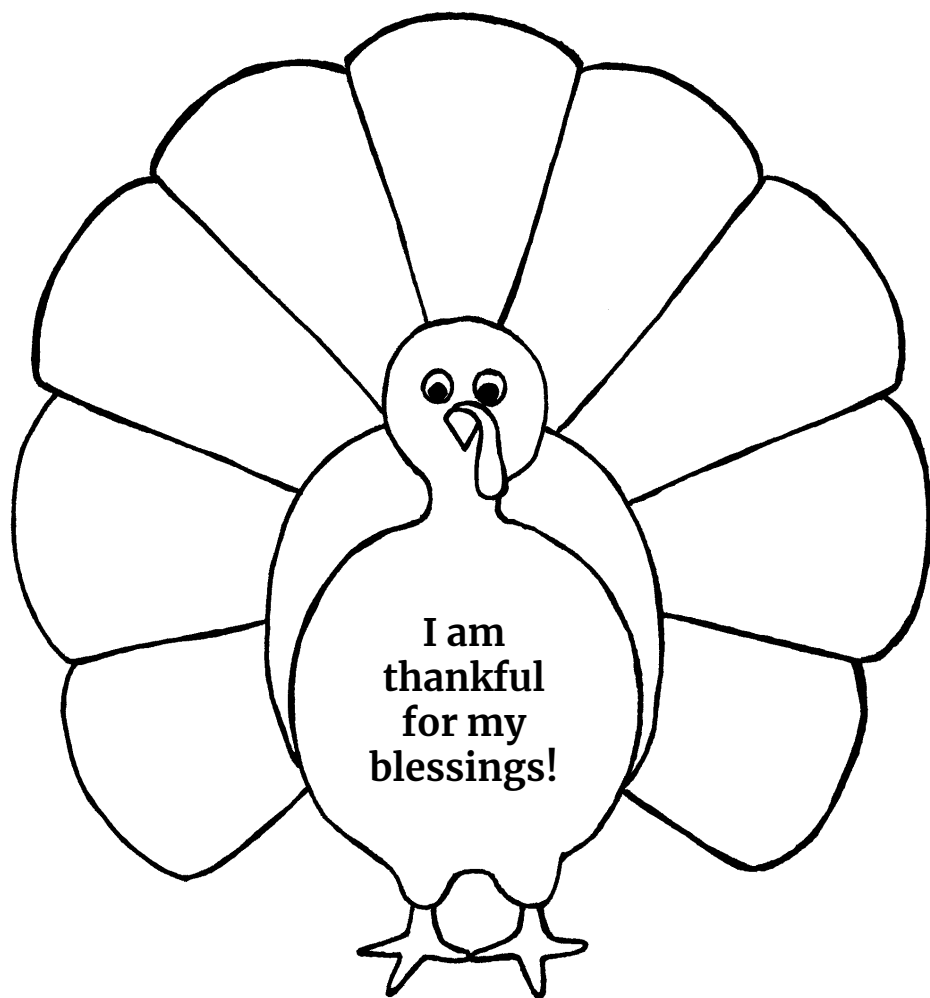
Jesus healed ten lepers.
