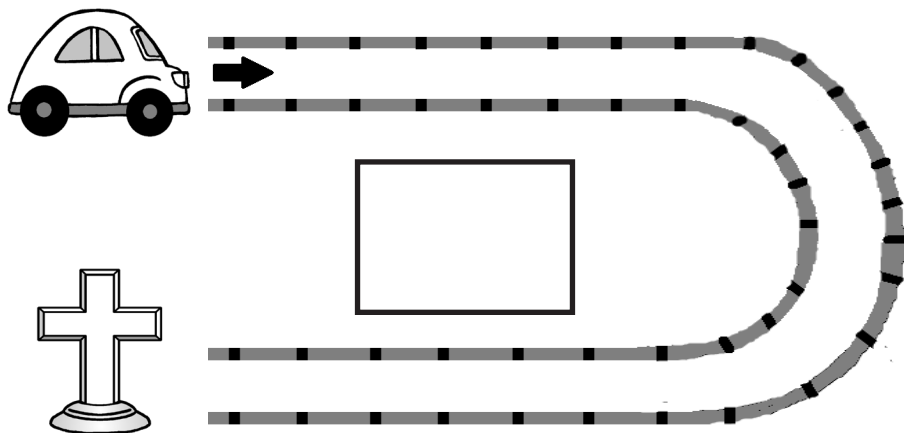
Today is Ash Wednesday, when people have ashes placed on their heads in the shape of a cross.

After this, **Jesus**, knowing that all was now finished, said (to **fulfill** the **Scripture**), “I **thirst**.” A **jar** full of **sour wine** stood there, so they put a **sponge** full of the sour wine on a **hyssop branch** and **held** it to his **mouth**. When Jesus had received the sour wine, he said, “It is **finished**,” and he **bowed** his **head** and **gave** up his **spirit**. Since it was the day of Preparation, and so that the **bodies** would not **remain** on the **cross** on the **Sabbath** (for that Sabbath was a high day), the **Jews** asked **Pilate** that their **legs** might be **broken** and that they might be taken away. So the **soldiers** came and broke the legs of the first, and of the other who had been **crucified** with him. But when they came to Jesus and saw that he was **already dead**, they did not break his legs. But one of the soldiers **pierced** his **side** with a **spear**, and at once there came out **blood** and **water**. He who saw it has **borne witness**—his **testimony** is **true**, and he knows that he is telling the truth—that you also may **believe**.
