Message Good morning! Are you putting money in your Mite Boxes? Don't forget to bring them back next Sunday. When Jesus came into the city of Jerusalem he came in a special way... on a donkey's colt. Do you know what a colt is? It's a little boy horse's that's under 4 years old. Donkeys have colts too. Jesus came on a donkey's colt because that's what the prophet said He would do. And when He came the people were very excited. They shouted HOSANNA!! HOSANNA TO GOD IN THE HIGHEST!! That's an interesting thing to say, don't you think? Because hosanna has an interesting meaning. Does anyone know what it means? (hopefully) Hosanna means "save us!" The people thought Jesus was going to be their new king. They didn't know what kind of week He was going to have. When we come into the church waving our palms and shouting or singing "Hosanna!" we're not saying, "Hooray Jesus!" We're shouting, "Save us Jesus!" because that's exactly what He was hoping He was going to do and what He did for everyone! I want to teach you a song: Ho-Ho-Ho-Hosanna Ha-Ha-Hallelujah He-He-He-He saves me and I've got the joy of the Lord. Have the kids practice each line, then put them all together, then have the congregation sing along. Let's pray.
