Message Look at this picture. [Picture 1] What do you see? That reminds me of a story. One day, Jesus was with people and some kids wanted to see him. When they started coming in the room, the disciples stopped them. They said, “Don’t bring kids here. This isn’t a place for them.” Well, Jesus heard and saw what they were doing. He stopped them and said, “Let the children come to me. Don’t stop them, heaven is for them too. If only you had as much faith in me as they do, you would be sure of being in heaven with me one day.” Look at this next picture. [Picture 2] Does it look like Jesus doesn’t want the kids around him? No. He’s hugging them and blessing them. Jesus loves all little children. Jesus loves everyone. How do we know that? You know what? I think there’s a song about that. You might know it. These are the words: “Jesus loves me, this I know...” What’s the next line? “For the Bible tells me so.” There it is. The Bible tells us that Jesus loves you, me, everyone. We know that because the Bible, God’s word, tells us. Let’s sing that song. [Be sure to include the whole congregation.] <i>Jesus loves me, this I know, for the Bible tells me so.
