This wasn’t the first time he prayed, and the disciples noticed. When he was done, one of the disciples said, “Lord, teach us to pray the way John the Baptist taught his disciples to pray.” You want to know what Jesus said? Tell me if this sounds familiar. Father, who is in heaven May your name be kept holy, May your kingdom come. May your will be done on earth the same way it’s done in heaven. Give us each day the food we need. Forgive us for the bad things we’ve done, As we forgive the bad things others have done to us. Don’t allow us to be tempted. Protect us from the evil one. Does that sound familiar? Anyone know what it’s called? It’s called the Lord’s Prayer. We call it that because Jesus, our Lord, taught it to his disciples and in the Bible, to us. When you get older you’ll go to Confirmation classes and learn more about it, but for now, you can learn it when we say it in church every week. Let’s try it.
