Message When Jesus told the disciples that He had to leave them and go back to heaven to be with His Father, they were sad. He was their friend and He helped them know the Father. If He went back to heaven, who would help them when they were wrong? Who would help them when they were confused? Who would help them when they didn’t know what to tell the people? Jesus knew what they were worried about and said, “Don’t worry. I’m not leaving you alone. I will ask the Father and He will send you another Helper to be with you forever.” Do you know who that other helper was? The Holy Spirit! Jesus called Him the Spirit of truth and that they wouldn’t be able to see Him because He would live... in their hearts! I can’t see in my heart, but I know He’s there. You know how I know? Because, when I was a baby, I got baptized and the pastor said, “I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.” When you were baptized, you got the Holy Spirit in your heart too.
