Part of the Bible readings today say, there is NOTHING that can take God’s love away from you. Does that sound good? He loves you no matter what you do. He loves you so much that he sent his Son to die for your sins. (Have kids repeat the phrase God loves me. If you want, add the actions: God (point up) loves (hands over heart) me (point to self.)) When I do something good, God loves me. When I do something bad, God loves me. When I’m happy, God loves me. When I’m sad, God loves me. When I say something right, God loves me. When I say something wrong, God loves me. When the sun comes up, God loves me. When the rain comes down, God loves me. No matter what I do, God loves me. No matter what I say, God loves me. There is NOTHING that can separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus, our Lord. Let’s pray.
